

**Problem:**

Slow legislation process.

**Aim:**

Domesticate Seed Laws/Regulations to SADC Protocol

**Specific objectives:**

1. To amend the “Seeds and Plant Varieties Regulations” to conform to SADC Protocol;
2. To enact a new Bill on plant health protection to repeal the Plant Control Act;
3. To develop Regulations on plant protection.
